



CHILE FJORDS - CHONOS ROUTE CRUISE

Sailing on the Motor Vessel Skorprios II, every Saturday and returning on Thursdays. From September to the end of April, from the Skorprios Terminal in the city of Puerto Montt, located 1,000 km south of Santiago and accessible by air or land, this 5-night sea voyage begins, sailing 800 miles towards the amazing encounter with the magical ancient ice of the San Rafael Glacier, sailing through spectacular archipelagos, channels and gulfs through the Chonos route to travel through this imposing territory where cities and towns such as Quemchi, Dalcahue and the fishing village of Puerto Aguirre are located, which show us in all its splendor the wonders of a vigorous nature that is best reflected in the Conejos Islet, Barrientos Islet and Quintralco Fjord, with its hot springs and excursions in its extensive sea dotted with islands.



ITINERARY

Day 1. Puerto Montt.

Depart from the Skorprios Terminal in Puerto Montt. Sail through the Llanquihue archipelago. Sighting of the city of Calbuco. Crossing the Gulf of Ancud. You will land in Quemchi, on the island of Chiloe where you will disembark by boat in this picturesque Chilote town, you will visit its artisan centre, its streets and cafes, as well as the house of Chilean writer Francisco Coloane. Once back on board you will continue south through the Chiloe archipelago, crossing the Corcovado Gulf.

Day 2. Puerto Aguirre and Barrientos Islet

Sailing through the Moraleda and Ferronave channels and arriving in Puerto Aguirre where you will disembark in this fishing village nestled in the Chonos archipelago, we walk through its



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streets, viewpoints, and a trail through a rainforest typical of the region. In the afternoon, back on board you will sail through the Ferronave and Pilcomayo channels and Casma Pass. Where you will arrive at Barrientos Islet, here we will disembark by boat, quietly approaching this group of rocky islands and visit this place with the largest number of seabirds in the Aysen region. We will see birds such as Imperial and Lillie Shags, Southern and Dominican Gulls, accompanied by South American fur seals that hang out on the rocks or in the sea. You will continue sailing south before spending the night at anchor in Quesahuen Cove or Leopardo Point, 20 miles from the San Rafael Glacier.

Day 3. The San Rafael Glacier

The ship sails through the San Rafael Roadstead and the Iceberg Channel. Entering the lagoon and anchors 2 km from the glacier. Motorboat excursion among multicolored icebergs, weather permitting. In the afternoon the ship will approach the glacier, before departing for the Quitalco Fjord.

****The San Rafael Glacier**** is absolutely magical, with its different sized and shaped ice floes; it is also one of the most active glaciers in Patagonia in terms of icefall and colouring. In the Laguna San Rafael National Park, Nature remains impervious to Motor Vessel Skorpions II as she sails silently on, and offers a spectacular landscape for all to see while they sail towards the Glacier itself on Hercules icebreakers. The glacier is 2,000 metres wide and its towers rise to a height of 70 metres, offering an unsurpassed spectacle while we toast each other with a glass of first class 12-year old whisky filled with chips of this incredible 30,000 year old ice formation.

Day 4. Quitalco

Docked at the Quitalco (meaning Fire Waters in Mapuche) is a fjord that lies on an ancient glacier bed, with high snow-capped mountains and an impenetrable and unique forest that grows next to a calm and transparent sea, in the middle of a temperate microclimate.. After breakfast, passengers can enjoy hot spring baths at 32°C and 38°C temperatures, in indoor or outdoor pools, and hike along the local trails. Weather permitting, motorboat excursions are available through the interior of the fjord. Late afternoon we will set sail for Chiloe, sailing through the Moraleda and Perez Norte channels.

Day 5. Chiloé and Conejos Islet

We sail through the Leucayec Channel. We cross the Corcovado Gulf. In this area, if conditions permit, we may have the chance to see blue whales or white-headed whales. We continue sailing along the eastern coast of Chiloe, arriving at 11:00 AM at Conejos Islet, located in the Queilen Channel. We disembark for a motorboat ride around this small island, home to Magellanic penguins and numerous local birds. We set sail between Lemuy and Chelín Islands. Arriving in Dalcahue, disembarkation, and sightseeing tour. We recommend the craft fair, the church, and a stroll along the waterfront. Departure for Puerto Montt. Farewell party, Captain's dinner.

Day 6. Puerto Montt

Breakfast while docked at the Skorpions Terminal. 9:00 AM. Passengers disembark.

Motor Vessel Skorpios II has a maximum capacity of 106 passengers in double cabins. Cabins have queen size beds or double beds, distributed in 53 decks. All the cabins have private bathrooms, Smart TV and music. The ship also has two comfortable Bar Lounges and a large dining hall. On board Skorpios II, in addition to receiving personalized attention from the crew, you will enjoy a refined cuisine that melds traditional international cooking with the best traditions of the south of Chile; our most attractive staples are king crab, giant mussels (*Mytilus*), cholga mussels, mussels, oysters, sea urchins and picorocos (*Austromegabalanus psittacus*), salmon, sea bass, conger eels, lobsters of the island of Juan Fernandez, red meats, white meats, all of which are always served with the best Chilean wines and the exclusive drinks and soft drinks offered by our traditional open bar. Skorpios II was built in 1988 and refurbished in 2010 at Skorpios Shipyards, Chile, according to SOLAS and IMO specification and with American Bureau of Shipping classification N° 890.56.66 A1 Ice Vessel. She has a

length of 70 metres, a width of 10 metres and a draft of 2.87 metres. She also has an International low-freeboard certificate and a registration Certificate N° 2567 issued by the Chilean Directorate General of Maritime
