## CLASSIC CROATIA CRUISE

A classic Croatian cruise, starting and finishing in Split and visiting the iconic sites of Dubrovnik, Hvar, Mljet and Korčula. Our small cruise vessel is custom made for sailing between the small ports on this coastline. We will stop for a swim everyday and on most evenings we are free to explore the restaurants and cafes of the towns where we spend our evenings. 3rd bed reduction (adult) - 30% 3rd bed reduction (child 3 - 7,99 years of age) - 70% 3rd bed reduction (child 8 - 11,99 years of age) - 50% Child ( 3-11,99 years of age) in twin cabin with 1 adult - 20%



### ITINERARY

Day 1. Split

We embark in Split, with a Welcome reception followed by dinner in the evening and a night's accommodation on board.

Day 2. SPLIT – BOL-STARI GRAD

In the morning we set sail towards Bol, a small town on Island Brač, for a swim at the Golden Horn. Enjoy the 530 m. long golden pebble beach, said to be the best in Croatia. It is unique in that it changes shape and position depending on the winds. Afterwards head to Stari Grad and overnight in one of the oldest towns in Europe.

### Day 3. STARI GRAD- HVAR – KOR ULA

We depart for the island of Kor ula after breakfast, with a stop along the way to swim, weather permitting, cool off and relax, with lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive at Kor ula, the most preserved medieval town whose street design is based on a fish bone pattern, to spend the night. You will have the possibility to book a tour of Kor ula. In the morning we depart for Hvar where you have the possibility of booking a guided tour. After the tour we head towards the island of Kor ula, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, with a stop along the way to swim, if weather permits, cool off and relax, with lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive at Kor ula, the most preserved medieval town whose street design is based on a fish bone pattern, to spend the night. You will have the possibility to book walking tour of Kor ula.

### Day 4. KOR ULA ISLAND – DUBROVNIK

In the morning we start sailing to Dubrovnik, stopping on the way for a swim, if weather permits. Lunch is on board, and in the afternoon we arrive in UNESCO World Heritage listed Dubrovnik - "Pearl of the Adriatic". We will spend the night in Dubrovnik. You will have the possibility to book walking tour of Dubrovnik with transfer included.

### Day 5. DUBROVNIK – MLJET NATIONAL PARK

Departing from Dubrovnik in the morning, our sail to Mljet Island includes a stop for swimming, if weather permits and lunch on

board. Croatian "Greenest island" will hypnotize you with its beautiful, untouched nature and its cultural heritage. We arrive in the heart of the National Park. If you want to visit it, you'll just walk to the entrance where you can purchase the ticket to walk around the Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and the Malo Jezero (Small Lake) and join the boat ride to St. Mary Island. This evening you can join the Captain's dinner onboard. We will spend the night in Mljet.

### Day 6. MLJET – MAKARSKA

In the morning we continue our adventure by sailing to town of Makarska, on the mainland, where we will spend the night. You will have the possibility to book the Wine Tasting excursion and enjoy and learn about the traditional Dalmatian wines.

### Day 7. MAKARSKA – SPLIT

In the morning we depart for Split, stopping along the way for a relaxing swim at one of the bays on Bra Island, if weather permits. After lunch on board, we arrive in Split and you will have the possibility to book the guided tour of Split, the historical centre of the city is listed as a UNESCO world heritage site. Overnight in Split.

### Day 8. Split

Disembark after breakfast.
