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COLOURS OF THE AEGEAN

Embark on a yacht cruise voyage aboard the Mega Yacht Variety Voyager and discover the best of the Aegean Sea. The white washed islands of the Cyclades, stepping stones of summer: Santorini with her sugarcube villages and the historical site of Akrotiri. Cosmopolitan Mikonos with her Windmills and the neighboring UNESCO-protected archaeological isle of Delos. Crete, the largest and southern most Greek island. The crystal blue waters of Vai at Crete, the largest and southern most Greek island. Lindos, a magnificent acropolis on a imposing rock and world famous archaeological site. Mystical Patmos and its UNESCO World Heritage sites. Lipsi islands and Simi, an off-the-beaten track island with her picturesque harbour. Bustling and colourful Bodrum in Turkey. Each day you will discover a new port of call, a hidden cove with crystal blue waters to cool you, a glimpse of ancient history to amaze you and rich cultural diversity to intrigue you.

ITINERARY

Day 1 (Saturday): Athens Marina Zeas - Cape Sounion - Delos, Greece
Embarkation 15:00 to 16:00 Sailing to Cape Sounio. Late evening swim stop and welcome dinner under the Temple of Poseidon. Late in the evening sailing to Delos. Overnight at sea.

Day 2 (Sunday): Delos - Mykonos, Greece

This morning we anchor near Delos Island, once the spiritual and commercial centre of the Aegean. Our short walking excursion will allow you to admire well preserved Hellenistic houses with beautiful mosaics, the Sanctuary, the ruins of a temple dedicated to Apollo Delos being Apollos mythological birthplace - the Sacred Way with the famous 7th century B.C. marble lions, guardians of the Sacred Lake and optionally the museum with its interesting exhibits. After our short excursion, we return to the ship and enjoy a refreshing swim before a deck BBQ. In the afternoon we sail to nearby Mykonos. We reach Mykonos early in the afternoon. Time at leisure in one of the trendiest islands in the World. Overnight in port.

Day 3 (Monday): Mykonos- Lipsi islands - Patmos, Greece

Early morning sailing to Lipsous Islands. Swim stop in a secluded beach and deck BBQ while sailing to Patmos. Early afternoon arrival in Patmos. Optional afternoon excursion . Overnight in port

Day 4 (Tuesday): Patmos, Greece - Bodrum, Turkey - Simi, Greece

Early morning sailing to Bodrum, Turkey. Morning arrival in Bodrum. Optional walking excursion to the Castle of St John built by the Crusaders , to several museums and monuments

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including the English Tower. After lunch sailing to Simi - Greece. We stop late in the afternoon at a secluded bay in Simi for a later afternoon swim before sailing into Simi port. Overnight in port.

Day 8 (Saturday): Marina Zeas/Athens, Greece

Disembarkation after breakfast at 9:00 to 9:30 am.

Day 5 (Wednesday): Simi - Lindos, Rhodes/Greece

Morning sailing to Lindos, Rhodes island. Arrival in Lindos. Optional excursion in the morning to the Acropolis of Lindos or time at leisure at Lindos Beach. Afternoon optional excursion to Rhodes Town. Late night sailing to Crete. Overnight at sea.

Day 6 (Thursday): Vai Bay -Aghios Nikolaos/Crete, Greece

Swim stop in Vai bay in Crete, a beach known for its crystal waters and palm forest. BBQ on deck and sailing along the coast line to Aghios Nikolaos. Clients taking the optional excursion to the Knossos Palace will leave from Vai and rejoin the ship in Aghios Nikolaos in the afternoon. The optional excursion will take us to the prehistoric (2000BC) Minoan Palace of Knossos, a world famous archaeological site located in a unique quaint scenery. Afternoon arrival in Aghios Nikolaos - Crete. Late night sailing to Ios / Santorini Overnight at sea

Day 7 (Friday): Manganari Beach/Ios - Santorini, Greece

Morning arrival at Manganari Beach Ios Island, one of the most photographed beaches in the Aegean. After our swim stop we will enjoy a deck BBQ and sail to nearby Santorini. Our afternoon optional excursion will take us up the cliff by cable car to Fira, the Archaeological Museum, the Akrotiri Site excavations and later in the afternoon to the Village of Oia, famous for its characteristic architecture and its sunsets. We will return to the ship for a late Farewell dinner while sailing away along the Caldera. Overnight at sea to Athens.

Dining Area Located on the Infinity deck, the glass enclosed dining room seats 75 passengers and allows for spectacular views around you, while dining in an elegant environment. treatments.

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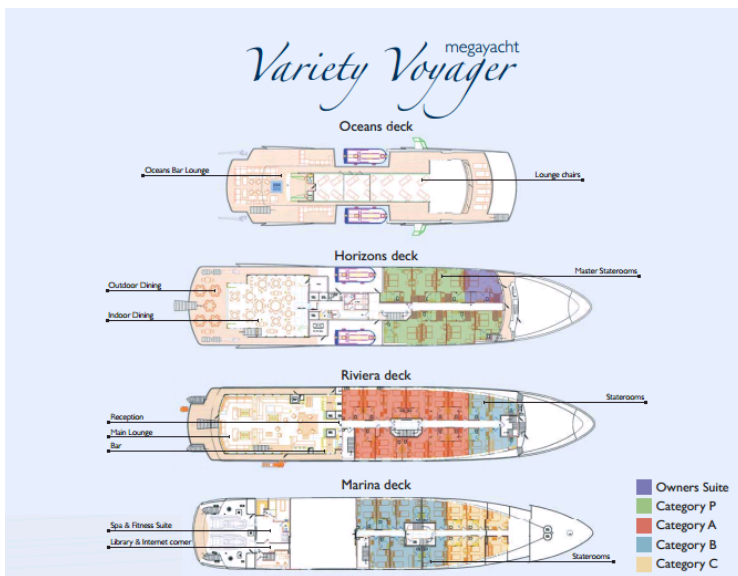
