Your cruise will start in Trogir, (Embarkation from 15.00) known as the little brother of Split. Picturesque Trogir is more compact and offers as much history and culture as its big brother. After your check-in, you will sail to Brač Island.

Brač is most known for its outstanding long, pebbly beach Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn) that can change shape depending on the currents.

Šolta Island in Croatia is one of the smaller and less island and a real travel highlight. Real highlight of Solta Island are the beautiful beaches and the breathtaking natural bays, which promise unforgettable swimming pleasure on the Adriatic Sea. In both cases You will set anchor in calm uand enjoy a delicious dinner onboard.

**Day 2 - Vis Island**

Vis Island is most well-known for its natural wonders - the Blue Cave and the Green Cave. Vis offers great options for fine dining, beaches and watersports activities, so there's plenty to do.

Stari Grad Old Town's highlight is Tvrdalj; Petar Hektorovic, a 16th century poet, fortified the castle with fish a pond that reflected the poet's love for fish and fishermen life.

Stari grad also offers a lots of restaurants specialising in local produce and flavours.


