## DUBROVNIK TO SPLIT MINI CROATIA CRUISE

A fabulous 6-day trip between Croatia's two most famous cities with the wonderful Dalmatian islands en route. ### Description Bring casual clothes and a casual attitude. Relax and let the captain and his crew (especially the chef) take care of you. Days are spent swimming, snorkelling, exploring the Adriatic blue and relaxing on deck. Evenings are at leisure to find a good restaurant or discover amazing historic treasures and monuments.



### ITINERARY

#### Day 1 DUBROVNIK

Check-in from 14:00h, cabins ready from 16:00h. Either explore the town on your own or join the guided tour starting at 17.00h followed by an optional cable car ride up to the Sr mountain for spectacular views of the old town. Don't miss STRADUN - both a street and a square in the old town and try to find time to walk at least part of the 1940 m long city walls, which have protected Dubrovnik during earthquakes and attacks! Overnight in the port of this magical town.

#### Day 2 DUBROVNIK - ŠIPAN / TRSTENIK

Morning departure towards the island of Šipan or the small town of Trstenik on the Pelješac Peninsula. Gorgeous spots for an afternoon swim and time at leisure with the possibility of visiting a local winery. In the evening, enjoy the special Captain's dinner

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on board (included on Premium Superior and Premium).

### Day 3 ŠIPAN OR TRSTENIK - KOR ULA

Korcula is the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. We will have lunch on board in a bay near Korula town. The encircling walls and bastions of Korula town date back to the 13th century, and there are some lovely churches and museums. Join the optional sightseeing of Korula town or optional wine and local appetiser tasting at a local winery before dining in one of the numerous seafront restaurants or konobas. Overnight in the port of Korula town.

### Day 4 KOR ULA - HVAR

Early departure towards the Paklinski Islands near Hvar (the longest island in the Adriatic) for lunch and a swimming stop. Later, there's an optional afternoon sightseeing of Hvar Town, which resembles a film set. The Renaissance cathedral has its original tower and the oldest community theatre in Europe, founded in 1612.

Take a short but steep walk up to the castle that dominates the skyline of Hvar. The castle houses a small museum and a cafe and bar, a great spot for a sundowner.

Hvar is known as a jet-set island, offering abundant entertainment, excellent restaurants, bars and cafes serving drinks long into the night. Overnight in Hvar.

### Day 5 HVAR - BOL, SPLIT

The next stop is the island of Bra. Bol is a typical fishermen's village that has kept its atmosphere despite becoming a popular tourist spot. From Bol, you can visit the most famous (and most photographed) beach in Dalmatia, Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn) - renowned for its ever-changing shape, a shingle bar that moves according to the wind and waves. Enjoy a walk through the pine forest from Bol to the Golden Horn beach.

The approach to the Split Riviera is wonderful and offers the best views from onboard. Upon early afternoon arrival, join the optional guided tour of Split, a monumental city which, together with the famous Roman Diocletian's Palace, is under UNESCO protection. Split is full of bistros and restaurants serving local specialties, as well as cool bars.

Antonela, based on a traditional Croatian coastal vessel design, was built in 2007 and has been refurbished on several occasions since. She is 33 metres long and carries 36 passengers in 18 cabins, all with en-suite shower and W/C, and air conditioning. There are 6 cabins on the upper deck, 4 on the main deck, and 8 on the lower deck. Cabins, including the bathrooms, measure around 12,2 sq. metres. Upper deck - 6 cabins, 2 x double bed cabins (1 with a third bed/bunk), and 4 twin cabins. Main deck - 4 cabins with twin beds Lower deck - 8 cabins, 4 with double beds and 4 with twin beds. Antonela has a large 180 sq. metre sun deck, a swim ladder to the rear for easy access for swimming, and a large dining room and bar.
