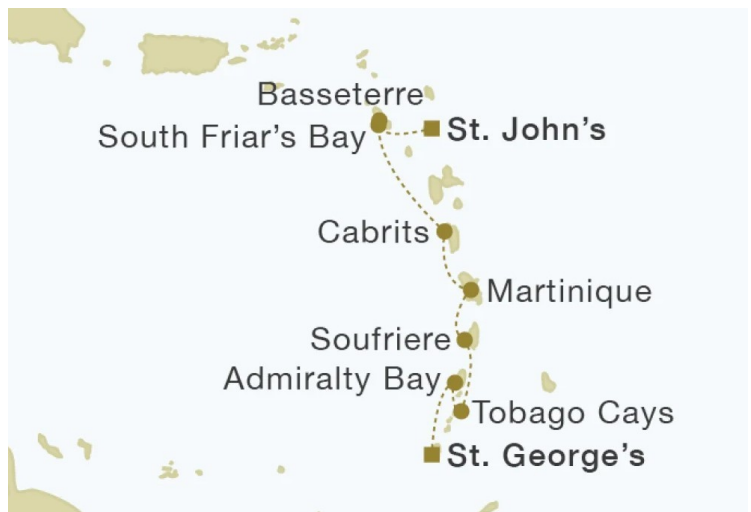


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GRENADA TO ANTIGUA 7 NIGHTS CARIBBEAN CRUISE

This sailing from St. George's to St. John's threads north through the Windward and Leeward Islands, pairing secluded anchorages with volcanic landscapes and colonial-era towns. The route calls at Admiralty Bay and the protected reefs of Tobago Cays before reaching the dramatic Pitons near Soufriere. Beach time in Martinique and rainforest scenery at Cabrits National Park add natural contrast, while historic Basseterre and the sands of South Friars Bay lead to Antigua's renowned yachting harbour.



ITINERARY

Day 1 St. George's, Grenada

The aromas of nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla baking in the sun - these are the tropical flavours of Grenada. From the horseshoe shaped Carenage at St. George's, follow the Sendall Tunnel (hand-built in 1895) to the Esplanade and old Ft. George for a spectacular view of Grenada.

Day 2 Admiralty Bay, Bequia, Grenadines

Star Clipper usually anchors in the lee of ruggedly beautiful Young Island lying just 54 feet off the southern tip of St. Vincent which is just a 10 minute ferry ride away. The natural harbour of



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Port Elizabeth at Bequia the world. The exquisite waterfront beckons you for a gentle stroll along the harbour.

Day 3 Tobago Cays, Grenadines

Four small islets, virtually deserted but enormously appealing for those who love underwater exploration, Tobago Cays is a national park where snorkelling is superb.

Day 4 Soufriere, St. Lucia

Marigot Bay, one of the prettiest anchorages in the Caribbean, is surrounded by lush hills and ringed by drooping coconut palms. Our alternate stop, the little Port Town of Soufrière was named after a nearby volcano. Prettier sights are to be seen at Diamond Falls and Mineral Baths where you can walk through the gardens and take a dip in the pool under the waterfalls.

Day 5 Beach, Martinique

Martinique's beaches are renowned for their stunning white sands and crystal-clear turquoise waters, offering picturesque spots for both relaxation and water sports.

Day 6 Cabrits, Dominica

Dominica is a dream-like island, full of surprises. Glide through a steamy orchid-festooned rainforest in a fascinating boat ride or hike to breathtaking Trafalgar Falls and a bubbling lake.

Day 7 Basseterre, St. Kitts (morning)

St. Kitts' was the first successful colony in the British West Indies. Shop in colourful Basseterre, play golf and tour old plantation houses. For the adventuresome there's a brisk hike through the rainforest.

Day 7 South Friars Bay - Beach, St. Kitts

The beach we visit is a beautiful beach with golden sands and calm, clear waters, ideal for swimming and snorkeling. The beach is flanked by lush hills and offers a tranquil setting, with several beach bars and restaurants providing a laid-back atmosphere.

Day 8 St. John's, Antigua

The dockyards, marinas, old inns, venerable pubs and convivial crowds of sun-tanned yacht crews; this is the epicentre of the Caribbean yachting world.
