ITINERARY

Day 1 Arrive Ljubljana

Be met on arrival in Ljubljana and transfer to your hotel. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner. Stay: Two Nights, Ljubljana, Hotel Cubo or similar

Day 2 Ljubljana

Embark on a guided discovery of Ljubljana today and make sure you have your camera handy to capture views from Ljubljana Castle. You will also delight in a wine tasting, where you will sample fine Slovenian varieties. The evening is yours at leisure.

Day 3 Ljubljana, Logar Valley

Farewell Ljubljana as you make your way to the Logar Valley, where you'll be astounded by the stunning scenery that greets you the moment you enter the valley. This rarely visited region is tucked away and offers a harmonious blend of peace and nature. Tonight, enjoy dinner accompanied by local entertainers. Stay: Two Nights, Logar Valley, Hotel Plesnik or similar

Day 4 Logar Valley

FREEDOM OF CHOICE You can't make a bad decision when it comes to choosing today's sightseeing inclusion, as they all perfectly showcase the best that the Logar Valley region has to offer. Perhaps get active and embark on a hike. For a more leisurely option, perhaps take a relaxing horse and carriage ride, or visit a traditional wooden granary. Today is devoted to exploring the alpine splendour of the Logar Valley, carved by glaciers over countless millennia.

Day 5 Logar Valley, Vogel, Bohinj, Bled

In Slovenia's alps, the villages of Vogel and Bohinj offer incredible vistas and evergreen slopes. Continue to Lake Bled and arrive at your hotel, which is part of the esteemed Small Luxury Hotels of the World group. With a history spanning 80 years, your hotel is set on the idyllic shores of Lake Bled. Stay: Bled, Grand Hotel Toplice, Lake View Room or similar

Day 6 Bled, Portorož

Board a traditional Pletna boat and enjoy a cruise to the island on Lake Bled. Afterwards, tour Bled Castle, whose origins date back to 1004. Then head to your hotel in Portorož. Stay: Two Nights, Kempinski Palace Portorož in a Superior Sea View Room or similar

Day 7 Portorož, Lipica, Piran

Explore the World Heritage-listed Skocjan Caves, also the largest known underground canyon in the world. Afterwards, visit a stud farm famous for breeding Lipizzan horses. This is the original farm responsible for perpetuating this breed, which are provided to the Spanish Riding School in Vienna. This evening, you will enjoy a discovery of beautiful Piran.

Day 8 Portorož, Embark Ship





Explore the fascinating Salt Pan, where salt is still produced using centuries-old processes of natural crystallisation. Later, gain an insight into truffle hunting, including a delicious tasting. Then transfer to Rovinj where you will embark the MV Lady Eleganza. Stay: 11 Nights, MV Lady Eleganza

Day 9 Rovinj, Pula

Explore Rovinj, which sits on a headland with houses huddled together beneath imposing St Euphemia church, whose steeple dominates the scene. This afternoon sail on to Pula.

Day 10 Pula, Mali Lošinj

Pula's remarkably preserved Arena, with its echoes of Rome's Colosseum, is the city's highlight. Built in the first century AD, it once housed up to 23,000 spectators for gladiatorial battles. Cruise on to Mali Lošinj.

Day 11 Mali Lošinj, Zadar

Lush and green clad, Lošinj Island is fragrant with lavender, sage and rosemary. The main town, Mali Lošinj, is characterised by pastel-coloured ship captains' villas on its waterfront. This afternoon sail to lively Zadar.

Day 12 Zadar, Šibenik

Zadar, located on a small peninsula, is a once-powerful maritime city – historically, it rivalled Venice in importance. Enjoy a morning tour before heading south to Šibenik.

Day 13 Šibenik, Spilt

Šibenik is the gateway Krka National Park's waterfalls. Spend the afternoon strolling along wooden boardwalks and crossing bridges to view the spectacle. Later set sail for vibrant Split, and take an evening walk around a city filled with Roman-era landmarks.

Day 14 Split, Vis

SIGNATURE EXPERIENCE Head to a small island to be met with a warm welcome from a local family on their private property. There is time for a swim, and to throw a fishing line into the Adriatic before a sumptuous traditional lunch. Leaving Split, the ship heads for a small island for an APT Signature Experience, and then on to Vis. This evening, you'll enjoy a BBQ dinner.

Day 15 Vis, Kor ula

Depart Vis, bound for the island of Korula, said to be the birthplace of Marco Polo. Arrive in the afternoon for a walking tour.

Day 16 Kor ula, Sunj, Lopud

SIGNATURE EXPERIENCE After a walking tour of Lopud's Old Town, enjoy the views from the ancient fort at a champagne reception. From Kor ula cruise to stunning Sunj beach on Lopud island. Following a swim, the energetic can take a two-hour walk, while the ship will cruise to meet them.

Day 17 Lopud, Kotor

Sail towards Montenegro and the Bay of Kotor. Cruising into the bay, framed by sheer cliffs that hug the walled town, is a highlight. This evening, enjoy a private tour of the town.

Day 18 Kotor, Dubrovnik

Enjoy free time in Kotor before cruising on Dubrovnik. This afternoon, explore the World Heritage-listed Old Town, before enjoying your last dinner on board this evening.

Day 19 Disembark Ship, Depart Dubrovnik
