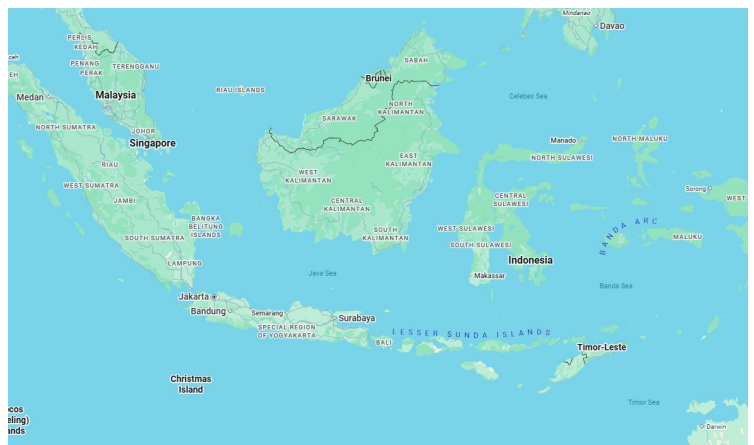
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SINGAPORE TO BALI - VOYAGE ACROSS THE JAVA SEA

Immerse yourself in cultural heritage with a visit to the UNESCO-inscribed Borobudur Temple, one of the largest Buddhist monuments in the world, and Prambanan Temple, the largest complex of Hindu temples in Indonesia. Enjoy a guided walking safari of Komodo National Park, home to the largest lizard on Earth, the Komodo dragon. Tour villages where you'll experience local culture, learn about batik, see acclaimed Balinese dancers and root for your favorites in a buffalo race!



ITINERARY

Day 1 Singapore | Embark

In the morning embark Heritage Adventurer. Join your fellow travelers for the Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner on board tonight.

Day 2 Day at Sea

Wake this morning to breakfast and stunning views as you spend a day cruising. Relax and enjoy some of the ship's many amenities while sailing east to the Java Sea and Borneo, Indonesia.

Day 3 Borneo, Indonesia

Today look out for orangutans and long-nosed proboscis monkeys during an excursion in Tanjung Puting National Park. Aboard a Zodiac boat, float through the tropical rainforest in search of these fascinating primates for a truly thrilling and memorable experience.

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Day 4 Day at Sea

Soak up stunning views as you spend a day cruising. Enjoy a lecture and delicious meals while sailing south to Semarang in Java.

Day 5 Semarang, Java

Choose an included excursion today. Visit the Borobudur Temple Compounds, one of the greatest Buddhist monuments in the world, built in the eighth and ninth centuries. After an Indonesian buffet lunch, continue on to Prambanan temple. Built in the 10th century, it is the largest Hindu temple in Indonesia, with 240 temples in the complex. As an alternative to that full-day excursion, opt for the guided tour of Semarang to observe the fascinating process of batik making, experience a traditional Indonesian lunch and explore Kota Lama's Dutch Old Town.

Day 6 Day at Sea

Enjoy a relaxing day at sea as the ship sails east to Badas in Sumbawa.

Day 7 Badas, Sumbawa

In Pamalang you'll be greeted by the head of the village before learning about the fascinating local culture. Observe community members pounding rice and weaving. Each region in Indonesia has unique weaving techniques, patterns and motifs. Next, experience the thrill of an exciting Sumbawa buffalo race. In this exhilarating cultural spectacle, pairs of water buffalo are harnessed together and guided by jockeys who ride on small wooden sleds, using their bare hands and feet to balance.

Day 8 Loh Liang, Komodo Island

Take a walking safari in Komodo National Park, celebrated for its stunning landscapes, diverse marine life and its most famous residents, the Komodo dragons. These formidable reptiles are Earth's largest lizards -- up to 10 feet in length and weighing up to 300 pounds -- and the top predators in their ecosystem. The park is home to other wildlife, including wild boars, water buffaloes, macaques and diverse bird and marine life populations. Enjoy a Captain's Farewell Reception and Dinner this evening.

Day 9 Bena, Bali | Disembark

This morning, disembark and continue with your onward travel plans.

Often referred to as the 'Grande Dame of Polar Exploration' due to her celebrated history and refined design, she was purpose-built for adventure in 1991 at Finland's Rauma shipyard and specifically designed for Polar exploration. Setting a peerless standard in authentic expedition travel, Heritage Adventurer (formerly known as MS Hanseatic) combines the highest passenger ship ice-class rating (1A Super) with an impressive history of Polar exploration. Having held records for the most northern and southern Arctic and Antarctic navigations, and for traversing both the Northwest and Northeast Passages, makes Heritage Adventurer perfect for pioneering experiential expedition travel. Originally designed to accommodate 184 guests, Heritage Adventurer now welcomes just 140 expeditioners ensuring spacious, stylish and comfortable voyages, while a fleet of 14 Zodiacs ensures all guests are able to maximise their expedition adventure. Heritage Adventurer proudly continues our traditions of exceptional, personalised expedition experiences as Heritage Expeditions flagship. Observation Lounge - One of the most celebrated and best-known features of Heritage Adventurer is the awe-inducing

Observation Lounge, Library and Bar. Located on Deck 7 and perched directly above the Bridge, enjoy sweeping 270-degree views through floor to ceiling windows, perfect for wildlife spotting and quick access to the outer deck. Bring your binoculars to spot wildlife, observe the ever-changing landscape, write in your journal or relax with a book. Observation Deck - Enjoy 360-degree views from the highest point on the ship. The Observation Deck sits above the Observation Lounge and provides exceptional outside viewing options. Stretching the full width of the vessel, this is the perfect spot to take in the surrounding land and seascapes. Perfect on a sunny day, recline in the comfortable sun loungers protected from the wind and elements and watch your voyage unfold. The Bridge - No expedition is complete without visiting Heritage Adventurer's busy nerve centre. Located on Deck 6, Heritage Expeditions' Open Bridge Policy means you are welcome to observe the Captain and crew at work while enjoying some of the ship's best views. It's a fascinating place to learn about navigation and vessel operations, however please note the Bridge will be closed when departing or arriving at port. Dining Room - Indulge in fine international cuisine from our talented chefs in the lavish surrounds of our Dining Room on Deck 4. Sensational 270-degree views provide a stunning backdrop to meals here along with an international wine list featuring many outstanding regional wines. discussions.

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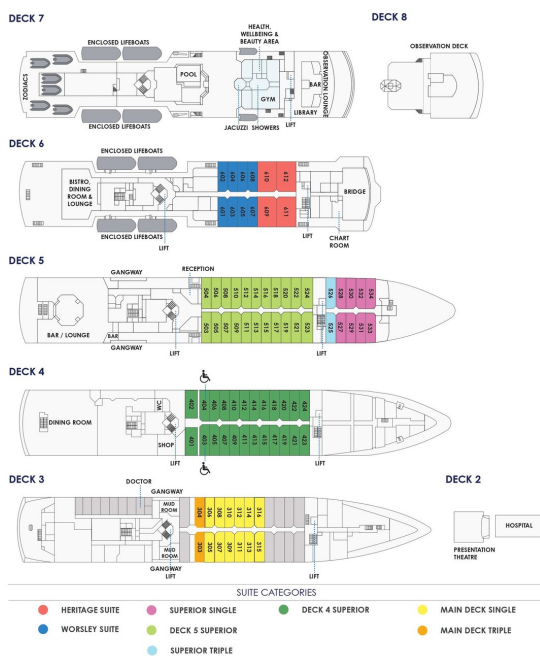
