Start the morning with a snorkel, discovering WWII wrecks in shallow waters of Deboyne Lagoon. Fishing, diving and sightseeing boats will also explore the lagoon and outer reef

before we visit Panepompom Island to meet the locals. After welcoming us at the beach, they'll treat us with some community canoe paddling and the opportunity to deliver appreciated resources to the local school. You'll have the opportunity to sail on their handmade boats back out to True North before an afternoon helicopter ride to see the Jurassic-Park-esque views of the Calavados Chain. Then, spend the afternoon fishing, diving, snorkelling or hiking on the beautiful island.

Day 09 Dechateau & Panasia Islands

Wake up in the incredible picturesque Karst Islands where you'll have the option to join a short hike into a cave system, relax on the stunning white beach or dive, snorkel or fish in the channels between these islands. Then head to a tiny island in the afternoon for a swim, sunset cocktails and an opportunity to explore.

Day 10 Alotau

As your journey draws to a close, we disembark in this serene coastal village that has been a gateway to the wonders of Papua New Guinea. After days filled with cultural discoveries, underwater marvels, and the warmth of local hospitality, you'll understand why Life's Different after True North.


