Night 01 Welcome Aboard

Welcomed aboard in the magnificent Sydney Harbour. We'll experience the harbour at its best, as the sun slowly sets, enjoying canapes and drinks while our expert guide points out the local areas of interest. Anchoring at Rose Bay, we'll settle in for a peaceful night's rest before an action packed week.

Day 01 Sydney Harbour





After a champagne breakfast, the harbour is our oyster! Visit Sydney's famed Taronga Zoo and the iconic Opera House, or take-off in the helicopter for a scenic flight over the bridge. Alternatively, visit Shark and Clarke island and discover the fascinating indigenous and colonial history of Sydney from our expert local guide. Departing later that afternoon, we will steam northwards to experience the Hawkesbury River the following day.

Day 02 Broken Bay

We awaken at Palm Beach, the jewel of the Northern Beaches made famous throughout classic Australian film and TV productions. A leisurely walk to historic Barrenjoey lighthouse provides an opportunity to enjoy spectacular views, and a refreshing swim in the surf. In the afternoon, we will visit the local Pearl and Oyster farms for a unique culinary and cultural experience, hopping back on board for live Jazz and cocktails as the sun sets.

Day 03 Hawkesbury

Today we will enjoy the dramatic landscapes of the Hawkesbury river, with activities to suit any taste. Choose from hiking the

magnificent and unspoilt bushland, exploring hidden coves on a scenic tender ride, beautiful scenic flights over Sydney's north shore region, or the unique experience of an Aboriginal art tour amongst the sandstone cliffs. In the afternoon we will 'raft-up' our tenders on the river for sunset drinks and canapes with a twist! To close out the day, we'll get back on board for a relaxing dinner cruise as we head down to Sydney Harbour again.

Day 04 New Years Eve




